

It is being observed that certain students are not attending their classes regularly and a few are found to be indulging in wayward activities.

It is notified that such students may be debarred from appearing in their forthcoming examination as per rules of the university and in extreme cases the award of degree may also be withheld.

For information of the students the relevant ordinance of the university is being quoted here under:

- 1. Degree of Bachelor of Laws in B.A.LL.B. (Hons) 5 Years Integrated Course. may be awarded to a candidate who after taking admission in the course, has received instructions regularly, passed the examinations and successfully completed the course of Study under the provisions of Ordinance of the university and is otherwise suitable by virtue of his character for the award of such Degree.*
- 2. A student shall be required to put in the minimum of 75% attendance in lecture classes in each subject and also at the moot courts and the practical training, seminar and other courses as prescribed by the university and Bar Council of India by its rules framed under Advocates Act, 1961/Faculty of Law, for being eligible to appear in the examination. However, the Board may in exceptional circumstances permit a student to appear in the examination who has to his credit up to 66% attendance as above.*
